In an effort to promote healthy choices for our students we are excited to inform you that Payson Canyon Half has partnered with our school for a kids marathon. Over the next three and a half months your child will be running each week towards their goal of completing a marathon (26.2 miles). This running will take place at school with your child's teacher supervising the running. Each child has set a goal to run 25 miles. Then on **Saturday, May 12 at 10:00am** all student are invited to run the final 1.2 miles of our kid's marathon in Payson. Each teacher will keep a log of the 25 miles run prior to our concluding event on May 12th.

If you want your child to run in Payson for the final 1.2 miles the parent will be responsible for registering you child/children and transportation to the event. Go to www.runpaysoncanyon.com to register. It is a \$15 registration fee which covers a race shirt and finisher medal. By using code NEBO20 you will receive 20% off registration prices. There is a scholarship program in place for students who wish to participate by are unable to pay the registration fee.
