Report on this year’s goals:

Throughout the discussion a Social Media and Digital Citizenship Plan was created.

Social Media and Digital Citizenship Plan:

- Collin Kartchner will present to the Sierra Bonita student body along with district wide parent presentation. Students, parents, and teachers will be encouraged to have an ongoing discussion about Social Media and Digital Citizenship. Follow up activities throughout the year will include the following: ongoing classroom discussions, NetSmart Presentation, classroom lessons, and student council videos.

team will include grade level teacher(s), school psychologist, school counselor, and district digital coach. Funds will be allocated to meet the needs of this plan.
