### **Sierra Bonita's Wellness Specialist: Erin Creamer:**

Mrs. Creamer presented to the council the Nebo Student Wellness Policy. She discussed that as a school we encourage non-food rewards. The rewards our school staff and PTA have chosen are listed: PTA birthday slap bracelets, behavior incentives such as Bear Brags, prize tower, etc. Our take home library has a challenge where they earn specific library bear brags. The improvements that they planning for is to continue to encourage healthy practices. Employees also have the opportunity to participate for incentives through the Wellness program which promotes incorporating health choices and lifestyles-step, wellness checks, incentives for participation if they are on the district's health insurance.

We also discussed that we will not be participating in the Payson Marathon this year. The council asked if we as a school could still do some kind of running or exercise challenge. Mrs. Creamer will be putting that together.

### **Review and Approve Safe Walking Route:**

Mr. Andersen shared the Safe Walking Route map with the council. They discussed the new crosswalk with flashing light signal and funneled entrance on 130 N 1400 E, which replaces the crosswalk on 200 N. No new suggestions or concerns were brought up. They did talk about a pedestrian gate at the railroad crossing on 400 N., which would block pedestrians when a train comes through. Mr. Andersen brings this up each summer at his safety meeting.

**Discussion of TSSA funds:**

As a council they reviewed the TSSA and SCC budget summary. Possible needs coming in the future are new sound systems for each classroom, replacement of outdated chrome books, and Smart Boards for teachers who will use them each day. A new technician will be hired next year.
