Report on Superintendent's School Community Council: Mary Hoyt:

- Building of SFHS, PHS, and SHS has begun. If new high schools are built in the future and other feeder schools will need to be built as well
- New elementary schools will not be built, boundaries may change in the future
- New safety entrances will be installed in elementary schools.
- Significant growth is happening in our district.

Online Safety discussion: Mr. Andersen:

As a council we reviewed the following documents:

- School Safety & Digital Citizenship Responsibilities
 - With a focus on the councils responsibilities
- Safe Technology Utilization & Digital Citizenship in Public Schools

Mr. Andersen also shared with the council what things we have in place at Sierra Bonita to protect our students.

- New Safety Entrances coming
 - This is where everyone is forced to enter through the front office
- All outside doors are on automatic timers
 - Front doors are the only doors that remain unlocked during school hours

- Back hall doors are unlocked during lunch to allow students access to the restrooms
- Recess technicians along with Mr. Andersen and Mrs. Shepherd are on recess duty to ensure the following
 - Overall safety of students
 - Stops individuals from coming on the playground
 - Encourage cars to move along rather than have students come and talk with them at the fence or parking lot
- Safety Drills
 - Earthquake
 - Lock Out
 - Lock Down
 - Fire
- Police radios in each school with a direct line to Police on patrol in case of active shooter or other situation without going through dispatch
- Active Shooting Trainings
- Teachers on duty before and after school around the inside and outside of school

Review Safe Walking Route:

Mr. Andersen showed the council <https://saferoutes.utah.gov/> and shared Sierra Bonita's Safe Walking Route. Parents are encourage to view the site and our route and walk their student(s) on the Safe Walking Route. Crosswalks are painted at the beginning of each school year. We have a new crosswalk with flashing lights and traffic funnel system. Students and drivers need to be aware of the rules and each other. The council parents shared that our staff does a great job of training our students how to safe around parking lots, loading and unloading zones, crosswalks, etc. They love the teacher presence outside before and after school.
